

Badminton Constitution

- Players must respect other members and behave in an appropriate manner. Players who do not will be first given a warning. If the problem continues, the player will be asked to leave.
- When playing a match, members should not complain about or abuse their teammates/ opponents and must not cheat (call lines incorrectly on purpose).
- No player should have the intention of destroying the feathers on a shuttlecock on purpose.
- Players have to listen to the members of the committee. The committee organise matches, fun games, etc. One can not decide themselves to walk on court and play without approval of a committee member.
