### **Safety Statement:**

This statement defines the health and safety policy of Maynooth University Traditional Music Society and the ways through which that policy is implemented. It is the Trad Society's aim to provide a safe and healthy environment in which all our members can prosper, and to make sure we fulfil all responsibilities to our members as a committee.

It is our goal to ensure we keep our members safe and healthy while eradicating/minimising potential risks at all our events. It is the Trad Society's intention to make sure any event we hold/equipment we use will not pose a risk to the safety or wellbeing of our members.

We will implement our approach in the following ways:

- Providing a safe environment for all events.
- Consult with members on possible improvements.
- Making health and safety a priority.
- Constantly identifying potential new and existing risks to health and safety.
- Providing any necessary safety equipment for members at events.
- Following the rules and guidelines of the Clubs and Societies office.
- Following the rules of our campus.
- Creating an equally safe and prosperous environment for all members.
- Reminding members of the duty of care they have to themselves and others.
- Ensuring all members are respectful of each other.
- Ensuring any member using equipment at an event or otherwise is qualified and has the skills to do so.

All committee are to be reminded of the following:

- All committee are not exempt and are expected to adhere to all society aims.
- Committee members should ensure all events pose minimal risk to themselves or other members.
- Committee members should ensure health and safety is a priority and all events.
- Committee members should ensure they follow the rules and guidelines set out by the Clubs and Societies office.
